### The Tarabino House

The Tarabino brothers of northern Italy  
traveled much of the U.S. before settling in  
the young and bustling town of Trinidad.  
They opened the Famous Department Store  
on Main Street in 1899, and soon began  
building what is still referred to by locals as  
the Tarabino House. Recognized by the  
National Park Service as a certified historic  
structure, the house remains much as it was  
nearly 100 years ago. The house rests  
within the Corazon de Trinidad National  
Historic District just two blocks from the  
Santa Fe National Historic Trail, and near  
the Scenic Highway of Legends.
